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Admissions Procedures

1. **After you have toured RCCA, submit an Enrollment Application Packet** (includes all listed items above) completed and submitted to the Registrar at trailblazers@rebeccacreek.org.
2. **Parent/Student Interview** will be initiated and scheduled by RCCA when the Enrollment Application Packet, the birth certificate, and transcripts have been received and reviewed.
 - a. Both parents/guardians and students must attend the interview.
 - b. An entrance exam may be required and administered to accurately determine your child's grade level and academic strengths and weaknesses.
3. **Final Acceptance** is provided by written notification. RCCA will send an email with the next steps and paperwork required to complete the admissions process. **The following must be received within 10 days of acceptance to ensure the student's place on the class roster:**
 - a. \$500 Enrollment Fee
 - b. Immunization Records or Notarized Affidavit issued by Texas Health Department for Exemption
 - c. New Student Medical Form
 - d. Annual Family Tuition Worksheet
 - e. Photo/Video Release Form signed
 - f. After School Care application submitted with \$50/child enrollment fee (if applicable)
 - g. If divorced or separated, most recent copy of court documents that define custody and visitation rights (if applicable)

Multiple-Child Discounts

RCCA offers a **family discount** to those with multiple children enrolled in the school year. The first student is charged the full tuition rate. **Each additional child receives a 5% discount off tuition only.**

Billing Schedule/Delinquent Accounts Policy

- **All tuition payments are due on the 1st of the month.**
- No statements will be sent as a reminder. However, you may track tuition by logging into the Parent Portal of Quickschools.
- Payments can be made via bank draft or credit card and set up automatically on the Parent Portal of Quickschools, or check/cash can be dropped off in person when tuition is due on the 1st of each month.

To help parents keep up regular payments, to prevent occurrence of insurmountable past due balances, and to enable RCCA to meet its financial obligations in a responsible fashion, the following delinquent account process has been established:

- **10 days past due:** The account is considered delinquent and a late fee of \$25 will be assessed each month the account remains past due.
- **30 days past due:** The account will receive a phone call from the administration office.
- **60 days past due:** Students may be suspended, and student records held until the account is made current.
- Returned Check or NSF charges to the school by the bank will result in a \$30 fee.

Tuition Assistance

- Rebecca Creek Christian Academy offers tuition assistance as needed upon receipt of an RCCA Tuition Assistance Application.

After School Care

Fees

- \$50/child, one-time enrollment fee (non-refundable)
- \$125 bi-weekly (every 2 weeks)/child
- No charge for week-long holidays (Spring Break, Thanksgiving, Christmas)

Payment Policy

- Payment for ASC use will be due on the 1st of each month.
- Any students not picked up by 6pm will be charged \$15/hour, or any part thereof.
- If an unenrolled child has not been picked up by 3:20pm from the carline, they will be sent to ASC and charged \$15/hour. After the child has utilized ASC three times, they will be required to enroll, pay enrollment fees and ASC bi-weekly rates.

ALL ACCOUNTS MUST BE PAID IN FULL TO RECEIVE TRANSCRIPTS OR STUDENT RECORDS.

Tuition Assistance Policy

PURPOSE

Rebecca Creek Christian Academy Scholarship was established in 2024 to provide tuition assistance to families that desire to pursue a Christian education for their child/children but need financial assistance to help with tuition costs.

The Rebecca Creek Christian Academy Scholarship is managed by Rebecca Creek Baptist Church.

CRITERIA

To qualify for tuition assistance, the following criteria must be met:

- Student/s accepted and to be enrolled at Rebecca Creek Christian Academy for a minimum of one school year.
- As part of the review process, applicants may be asked to participate in an in-person interview with school board members and the Head of School.
- Demonstrate the need for financial assistance.

PROCESS

- Requests must be made by the person requesting tuition assistance.
- Requests should be mailed or emailed to the Registrar.

- All requests will be reviewed by the Head of School/ School Board.
- The board will determine the amount of assistance to be approved.
- The board will then notify the Head of School of their determination.
- The requester will be notified in writing of approval/ denial.
- The amount approved will be credited to the requester's tuition balance.

Admissions Philosophy

Our purpose is to serve families who desire not simply a private education, but a distinctively Christian education for their children. We have adopted an admissions policy that opens Rebecca Creek Christian Academy for families:

- Who agree to be supportive of our faith, philosophy, objectives, standards of education, and religious mission,
- Whose children meet our enrollment standards.

RCCA reserves the right to select students based on academic performance, religious commitment, lifestyle choices, and personal qualifications including a willingness to adhere to its policies. It must always be understood that attendance at RCCA is a privilege and not a right. If at any time a student's conduct, academic progress, or cooperation with RCCA administration is not in keeping with the school's policies and/or Statement of Faith, the School Board reserves the right to take disciplinary action, up to and including dismissal from RCCA.

RCCA Statement of Faith

God's Truth can be found in the pages of Scripture. We believe that the Word of God is the only sure foundation upon which to build your child's life. That is why we make no apology for taking a strong Biblical stand, seeking to help you ensure that the Word of God is the reliable guide your child will hold to all the days of his/her life. We believe the Bible is clear in its teaching on many vital subjects. We believe in the verbal, plenary inspiration, and authority of the Scriptures. We believe that the Bible reveals God, the fall of man, the way of salvation, God's plan and purpose for the ages, and how to live this life victoriously. The King James Version of the Bible is the sole translation used at Rebecca Creek Christian Academy.

God the Father, God the Son, and God the Holy Spirit. We believe in the deity, virgin birth, and bodily resurrection of Jesus Christ. We believe that salvation is by grace plus nothing and minus nothing. The conditions for salvation are repentance and faith. We believe that men are justified by faith alone and are accounted righteous before God only through the merit of our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ. Justification is an eternal relationship that can never be broken. We believe in the visible, personal, and premillennial return of Jesus Christ. We believe in the ever-lasting conscious blessedness of the saved and the everlasting conscious punishment of the lost.

Creation of Man/Woman. We believe that God wonderfully and immutably created each person as male and female. These two distinct, complementary genders together reflect the image and nature of God (Genesis 1:26-27). Rejection of one's biological sex is a rejection of the image of God within that person.

Marriage, Gender, and Sexuality. We believe that the term "marriage" has only one meaning: the uniting of one man and one woman in a single, exclusive union, as delineated in Scripture (Genesis 2:18-25).

We believe that God intended sexual intimacy to occur only between a man and a woman who are married to each other. (1 Corinthians 6:18, 7:2-5; Hebrews 13:4). We believe that God has commanded that no intimate sexual activity be engaged in outside of a marriage between a man and a woman.

We believe that any form of sexual immorality (including adultery, fornication, homosexual behavior, bisexual conduct, bestiality, incest, trans-genderism, and use of pornography) is sinful and offensive to God (Matthew 15:18-20; 1 Corinthians 6:9-10).

We believe that in order to preserve the function and integrity of Rebecca Creek Christian Academy, and to provide a biblical role model to the Rebecca Creek Baptist Church families and the community, it is imperative that all students and families who attend and personnel employed by Rebecca Creek Christian Academy in any capacity, or who serve as volunteers, agree to and abide by this statement on marriage, gender and sexuality (Matthew 6:16; Philippians 2:14-16; 1 Thessalonians 5:22).
